Overview

The Law Society is seeking the support of junior lawyers (0-3 years ppe) to test an online career course. This pilot is part of the wider work underway to define and design the Law Society's position as a learning and career development partner and provider for our members.

95% of our members have told us that career development is important in their early career. In response, in this first year the Law Society will create a pilot package of virtual and face to face support for newly qualified solicitors. This Be Bold online career health check tool and online career coaching programme is one of the elements to be tested. We will learn what works in this first year with a view to rolling out to the wider profession from 2020.

Junior lawyers 0-3 years ppe looking to invest in their own personal career.
